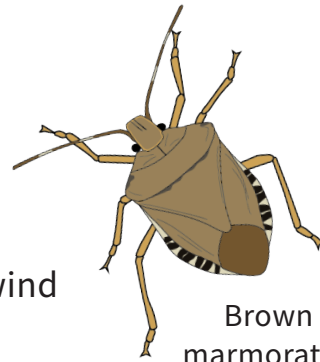




Scavenger Hunt

- A plant with sticky or clingy seeds or other parts



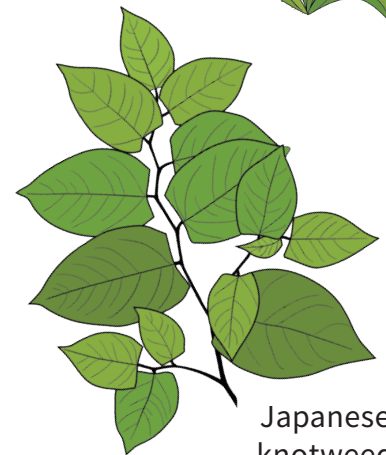
Brown marmorated stink bug



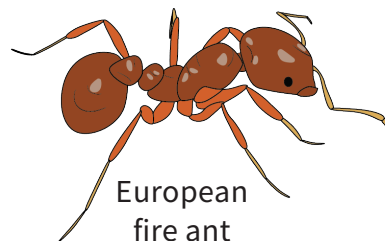
Orange hawkweed

- 3 animals on or in the ground



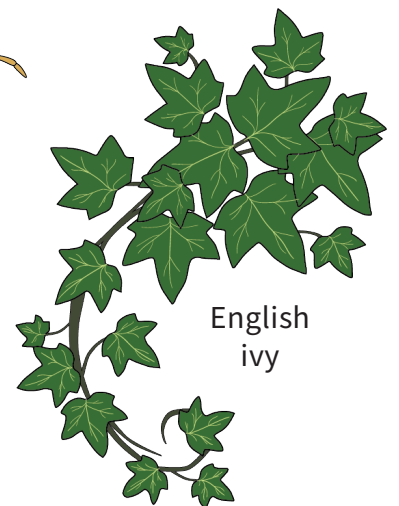
Japanese knotweed

- An animal track



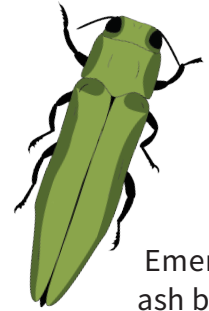

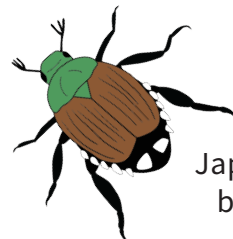

PARTNER UP

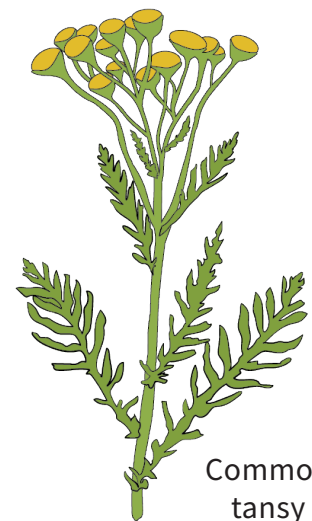
- Find a “mystery”- something you are curious about. Show it to a buddy and discuss your wonders!
